Introduction

Certified Estill Voice Training (EVT) representatives are recognized internationally for their extensive knowledge of the voice and for the innovative teaching techniques they employ. An elite group, EVT representatives are advanced in their abilities to use scientific principles in the service of art.

Central to the success of these representatives is the Estill Voice Training. Developed through extensive research and based upon scientific principles, the Estill Voice Model continues to be refined as research becomes available. Certification assures consistent quality and expertise in the delivery of the Estill Model by its representatives thus protecting the integrity of this unique system.

Certification protocols are governed by the Estill International's Advisory Board and applied consistently in all the countries where EVT is taught. The value of this certification program is enhanced by the rigors of the examination standards.

EI awards a Certificate of Figure Proficiency (CFP) to individuals who can demonstrate the basic options for voice control taught in EI-approved EVT Level One (Compulsory Figures for Voice Control) and Level Two (Figure Combinations for Six Voice Qualities) courses. The CFP is not an obligatory prerequisite for more advanced certification levels; however, the certificate is recommended before pursuing credentialing at any other level.

EI offers two sequential levels of certification for those who would like to teach EVT. The Certified Master Teacher (CMT) is awarded to persons who demonstrate the ability to teach the Estill Voice Training to individuals and/or small groups. Certified Course Instructors are EVT teachers who demonstrate advanced understanding of the Estill Voice Model and the anatomy, physiology, acoustics, and research that are its foundation. The CMT earns Estill International's endorsement for teaching EVT in a private studio or classroom setting. CCIs are promoted as presenters of EVT in public courses and seminars. Both CMTs and CCIs are considered to be Estill Voice Training Representatives.

Educational institutions with 2 or more faculty members certified as EVT Representatives (CMT or CCI) are eligible to become Educational Affiliates (EA). EI offers many benefits to its EAs, including course material discounts and website promotion.

Length of Exam	½ day for the written and Estill Voiceprint examinations As many observations as needed to “pass” teaching of all concepts, Figures and Qualities presented in Level One and Level Two courses

CMT Requirements: Phase One	Attend EVT Level One and EVT Level Two courses as many times as necessary to gain proficiency in option demonstration and teaching skills (private coaching, advanced workshops may be required) Pass the CMT Estill Voiceprint Examination Pass the CMT Written Examination (includes basic anatomy, physiology, and common voice problems—as they are presented in Level One and Two Courses)
Passing Criteria	Voiceprint Protocol: A correct production must be recorded within 3 trials Written Exam: 90%
Post-Phase One Procedures	Complete the EI Contact & Update Form (with report of CMT-Candidate Status) * EI sends CMT Observation Packet which includes all forms required for Phase Two observation requirement
CMT Requirement: Phase Two	Pass teaching all concepts, Figures, and Qualities in 1:1 and/or small group instructional settings (multiple observation sessions/course internship* experiences may be required to successfully complete all Phase Two requirements)
Post-Phase Two Procedures	Complete & submit the EI Contact & Update Form (with web-posting information) Sign & submit the Letter of Agreement Remit the CMT Annual Fee (fee schedule available on www.TrainMyVoice.com) EI sends CMT Certificate and posts CMT's biographical and contact information on www.TrainMyVoice.com EI provides access to EVT Representative Intranet

EVT-Certified Course Instructor (CCI)

Eligibility	Individuals already certified as Certified Master Teachers
Exam Description	Phase One: Written and Oral examinations Phase Two: Presentation Observation during public courses as a Course Assistant (must present in at least 3 Level One and 3 Level Two Courses to complete this requirement)
Length of Exam	½ day for the written and oral examinations Present as Course Assistant in at least 3 Level One and 3 Level Two Courses (additional observations may be needed to meet this requirement)
Examiner	Phase One: Certified Course Instructor with Testing Privileges designated by EI as qualified to test at this level Phase Two: CCI willing to mentor a CCI-Candidate

CCI Requirements: Phase One	Earn the CMT Declare Intent to Pursue CCI Certification to EI (mail or e-mail to Certification Director) Pass the CCI Written and Oral examination (includes complex anatomy/physiology, advanced acoustics, vocal pedagogy, vocal health, speech science, advanced spectrogram interpretation, and knowledge of Jo Estill's research)
Passing Criteria	Written and Oral Exams: 90%
Post-Phase One Procedures	Complete & submit the EI Contact & Update Form (with report of CCI-Candidate Status) * EI sends CCI Observation Packet which includes all forms required for Phase Two observation requirement and grayscale presentation slides for practice purposes.
CCI Requirement: Phase Two	Pass presentation of all concepts, Figures and Qualities during at least 3 Level One and 3 Level Two courses. (additional Course Assistant** experiences may be required to successfully complete all Phase Two requirements)
Post-Phase Two Procedures	Complete & submit the EI Contact & Update Form (with web-posting information) Sign & submit the CCI Letter of Agreement Remit the CCI Annual Fee (fee schedule available on www.TrainMyVoice.com) EI sends CCI Certificate and posts CCI's biographical and contact information on www.TrainMyVoice.com EI sends course production materials and provides access to CCI section of EVT Representative Intranet
